ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 08-02

The standing chapter 13 trustees in this district have recommended that the court adopt the new local form "Debtor's Certificate of Compliance with Conditions Related to Motion for Hardship Discharge with Notice Thereon" for submission by chapter 13 debtors when the debtor submits a motion for a hardship discharge under 11 U.S.C. Section 1328(b) for cases filed on or after October 17, 2005. The court, having reviewed the form and determined that it is necessary to adopt this form for the efficient processing of chapter 13 hardship cases, hereby **ORDERS** that:


1. In a case filed on or after October 17, 2005, when the debtor submits a motion for a hardship discharge under 11 U.S.C. Section 1328(b), the debtor shall also complete and file the local form "Debtor's Certificate of Compliance with Conditions Related to Motion for Hardship Discharge with Notice Thereon." This form will be available on the court's website at: <http://www.nvb.uscourts.gov/>. In a joint case, both debtors must complete this form.

2. Once the "Debtor's Certificate of Compliance with Conditions Related to Motion for Hardship Discharge with Notice Thereon" is filed with the court, it will be noticed through the Bankruptcy Noticing Center (BNC) to all creditors.


3. If no objections are filed within 15 days after service of the "Debtor's Certificate of Compliance with Conditions Related to Motion for Hardship Discharge with Notice Thereon," and if the debtor is otherwise eligible to receive a discharge, the court may issue a discharge in the case. If an objection is timely filed, it will be considered at the hearing on the debtor's motion for hardship discharge.

4. Failure to timely file the certification may result in the case being closed without entry of a discharge.
