FILING A PERSONAL FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT CERTIFICATE

Effective October 12, 2014, a change was made to the option for "Filing a Personal Financial Management Certificate" available on the Nevada Bankruptcy Court's web site. A PACER login will be required in order to utilize this feature.

After reviewing the "Notice to Approved Personal Financial Management Course Providers" found on the court's webpage, <u>http://</u> <u>www.nvb.uscourts.gov/filing/bankruptcy-basics/personal-financial</u> <u>-management-certificate/</u>, and clicking on the "Click Here to File A Personal Financial Management Course Certificate (eFinCert)," the user will be prompted for a PACER login:

Official Form B1, known as a "Voluntary Petition" must be filed by a debtor to begin a bankruptcy case.



STEPS TO MANUALLY OPEN A VOLUNTARY PETITION

(Note: Steps 2-6 should be done immediately after opening.)

- 1 Upload VOLUNTARY PETITION
- 2 Upload MATRIX

- 4 Docket STATEMENT OF SOCIAL SECURITY
- 5 Docket DECLARATION OF ELECTRONIC FILING
- 6 Docket **MEANS TEST** (Individuals Only)
- 7 Docket CERTIFICATE OF CREDIT COUNSELING (Individuals Only)
- 8 Docket CHAPTER 13 Plan (if Applicable)
- ALL Chapter 13 and 11 cases are opened as ASSET cases.



JUDGE/TRUSTEE ASSIGNMENT

THIS IS A VERY IMPORTANT STEP in opening a new petition.

It is a crucial part of case opening, and will ensure that you receive your 341 notice immediately.
