COURT CALENDARS

Online calendars are updated daily. Consequently, the calendars may be modified several times prior to the actual hearing. Court calendars are provided as a convenience to the public and legal community and are subject to change without notice.

On the day of the actual hearing, prior to your appearance in the courtroom, please check the kiosk outside of the courtroom for the **correct matter number**. The matter numbers may have been modified from the last online calendar update. To use the **Court Calendar** function on the kiosk, touch anywhere on the screen to get started. **Court Calendars** allows the user to select a judge (including visiting judges) and see a list of all court hearings for that judge. You can also search for specific court hearings by party name or case number on the Search tab.

ADDING CREDITORS

If an amendment is filed adding creditors in accordance with Fed. R. Bankr. P. 1009(a), the debtor **must** send the added creditors a copy of the Notice of Chapter ____ Bankruptcy Case, Meeting of Creditors, & Deadlines . The debtor must also pay applicable fees, file a Certificate of Service in accordance with [LR 2002\(a\)\(3\)](#) and update the master mailing list pursuant to [LR 1007\(b\)](#).

Looking for an event in CM/ECF and can't find it? You can search menus and events in CM/ECF. Just click on the search menu, and then type in the word(s) to search.
