## ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2016-04 - INDIVIDUAL CHAPTER 11 DISCHARGES

Administrative Order 2016-04 goes into effect August 1, 2016. This administrative order modifies LR 3022.1. When a debtor files a motion for discharge, they must now file the Certificate of Compliance as an <u>exhibit</u> to the motion, and notice all creditors.



#### AUTOMATED CLEARING HOUSE (ACH) IN CM/ECF

Effective July 1, 2016, electronic filers will be able to pay fees through the U.S. Treasury's on-line payment provider, Pay.gov, using Automated Clearing House (ACH). ACH is an electronic funds transfer system that permits payment of filing fees through a direct debit from your personal or business bank account. Be sure to check with your financial institution to insure your account allows you to make ACH transactions. In addition, Pay.gov will continue to accept payments through credit card transactions. With the addition of ACH, the payment screens will change. Below are screen shots that depict how the new payment screens will appear. If you have questions regarding this change, please contact the court at (866) 232-1266.

#### Automated Clearing House (ACH) - Direct Payment

The first payment screen (Option #1, see Figure 1) pertains to paying with your personal or business checking/savings account. If you are paying by credit card and not ACH, continue to scroll down to the second payment screen (Option #2, see Figure 2) which allows for payment by credit card (American Express, Discover, MasterCard or Visa). Always complete the fields with a red asterisk when selecting a payment type.

### STEPS TO MANUALLY OPEN A VOLUNTARY PETITION

Official Form B101/201, known as a "Voluntary Petition" must be filed by a debtor to begin a bankruptcy case.

Note: Steps 2-7 should be done immediately after opening.

In CM/ECF, click on Bankruptcy. Then click on the following Bankruptcy Events, answering the prompts that appear.

- 1. Open Voluntary BK Case (All Chapter 13 and 11 cases are opened as ASSET cases).
- 2. Creditor Maintenance → Upload list of creditors file.
- 3. Judge/Trustee Assignment. **THIS IS A VERY IMPORTANT STEP** in opening a new petition. It is a crucial part of case opening, and will ensure that you receive your 341 notice immediately.
- 4. Miscellaneous Statement of Social Security Number(s).
- 5. Miscellaneous Declaration re: Electronic Filing.
- 6. Miscellaneous \_\_\_\_\_ select applicable Income Means Test events.
- 7. For Individuals Only: Miscellaneous Certificate of Credit Counseling.

The following applies to Chapter 13 cases only. Search for a Chapter 13 Plan Confirmation hearing (initial hearing only) date from the self-calendaring section on the court's website, <u>http://www.nvb.uscourts.gov/calendars/self-calendaring-dates/</u>.

8. Plan → Chapter 13 Plan #1.
