With the Chapter 7 Panel Trustees moving to credit card payments for Court filing fees, the Panel members would otherwise be required to seek Court approval to reimburse themselves from the affected Bankruptcy Estate each time a court filing fee was paid by credit card. As Court filing fees are routine, it is likely that there would otherwise be a significant number of these motions, and these motions are likely to be routinely granted. It is therefore,

**ORDERED**, that trustees administering cases under Chapter 7 of the Bankruptcy Code in the District of Nevada in connection with the payment of Court filing fees by Chapter 7 Panel Trustees by credit card, the Chapter 7 Panel Trustees may reimburse themselves Court filing fees from available funds in the respective Bankruptcy Estates without further order of the Court. Reimbursement is subject to future review and possible disgorgement by further order of the Court. It is further

**ORDERED**, that this Administrative Order is effective for all Chapter 7 cases currently pending or filed/reopened after the date of this Order.
