**ORDER UNDER BANKRUPTCY RULE  
1007 (c) GRANTING AN EXTENSION  
OF TIME TO FILE STATEMENT OF  
FINANCIAL AFFAIRS AND  
SCHEDULES OF ASSETS AND  
LIABILITIES**


Upon the motion, dated June 20, 2003 (the "**Motion**"), of the above-captioned debtor and debtor-in-possession (the "**Debtor**"), for an order granting the Debtor a forty-five (45) day extension of time to file its Statement of Financial Affairs and Schedules of Assets and Liabilities (the "**Statement and Schedules**"); and upon the "Declaration of Andrew A. Stevens in Support of Chapter 11 Petition and First Day Motions" this Court finds that: (i) it has jurisdiction over the matters raised in the Motion under 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; (ii) venue of this matter is proper under 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409; (iii) this matter is a core proceeding under 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2); (iv) the relief requested in the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtor, its estate, its creditors, and other parties-in-interest; (v) adequate and proper notice of the Motion and the hearing thereon has been given and that, considering the emergency nature of the relief requested, no other or further notice is necessary; and (vi) good and sufficient cause exists for the granting of the relief requested in the Motion as set forth herein,

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IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:

Under Rule 1007(c) of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, the Debtor is granted an additional forty-five (45) days in which it timely can file its Statement and Schedules, making the Statement and Schedules due on or before July 31, 2003, which is sixty (60) days from the Petition Date.
