P. 6004 Authorizing Debtors to Assume Executory Contracts with the Federal Government; and upon the record herein; and after due deliberation thereon; no objections thereto having been filed; and good cause appearing therefor; it is hereby

FOUND THAT:

A. The relief requested in the Motion is in the best interests of the Debtors, their estates, their creditors and other parties-in-interest.

B. Proper and adequate notice of the Motion has been given and no other or further notice is necessary.

C. The Debtors have exercised sound business judgment and have satisfied the requirements of 11 U.S.C. § 365 in deciding to assume the Government Contracts; and it is therefore,

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ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT:

1. The Motion is GRANTED.


2. The Debtors are authorized under 11 U.S.C. § 365 to assume, and are hereby deemed to have assumed the Government Contracts.
