AMENDMENT OF LOCAL RULE 9037

[Administrative Order 2020-15](#) went into effect on September 1, 2020. This Administrative Order modifies Local Rule 9037. In order to redact personal data identifiers from a document other than a transcript, a party must file a Notice of Redaction instead of a motion and order. The redacted document **must** be included as an attachment to the Notice.

Any request to redact information other than personal data identifiers, as defined by Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9037(a), must be submitted to the court by motion.

U.S. TRUSTEE PROGRAM EXTENDS TELEPHONIC OR VIDEO SECTION 341 MEETING

The [U.S. Trustee](#) Program has extended the requirement that section 341 meetings be conducted by telephone or video appearance to all cases filed during the period of the President’s “Proclamation on Declaring a National Emergency Concerning the Novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19) Outbreak” issued March 13, 2020, and ending on the date that is 60 days after such declaration terminates. The Proclamation was issued on March 13th and continues until the President declares we are beyond the national health emergency. However, the U.S. Trustee may approve a request by a trustee in a particular case to continue the section 341 meeting to an in-person meeting in a manner that complies with local public health guidance, if the U.S. Trustee determines that an in-person examination of the debtor is required to ensure the completeness of the meeting or the protection of estate property. This policy may be revised at the discretion of the Director of the United States Trustee Program.

PROPOSED FEDERAL RULE AMENDMENTS PUBLISHED FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

On June 23, 2020, the Judicial Conference Committee on Rules of Practice and Procedure (Standing Committee) approved publication of proposed amendments to the following:

Appellate Rule 25;

Bankruptcy Restyled Rules Parts I and II; Rules 1007, 1020, 2009, 2012, 2015, 3002, 3010, 3011, 3014, 3016, 3017.1, 3017.2 (new), 3018, 3019, 5005, 7004, and 8023; and Official Forms 101, 122B, 201, 309E-1, 309E-2, 309F-1, 309F-2, 314, 315, and 425A;

Civil Rule 12 and Supplemental Rules for Social Security Review Actions Under 42 U.S.C. § 405(g); and

Criminal Rule 16.
