## **RSS FEEDS AND EMAIL UPDATES**

The U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of Nevada offers [Really Simple Syndication \(RSS\)](#) feeds for news and information, allowing you to stay current on the court's latest updates and events. When we post new content to the website, you can receive automatic updates through our RSS feeds.

You may also subscribe to a feed of docket entries filed in CM/ECF. The feed reports categories such as answers, appeals, orders, miscellaneous entries, and trustee entries.

To access this feature, visit <https://ecf.nvb.uscourts.gov> and click the **Court Information** link located in the bottom left corner of the page. On the Court Information page, select the **RSS Feed** option and then choose **Entries made in the last 24 hours – Public Users**. You may view the feed in your browser or use RSS reader software (such as Feedreader).

The court also offers a free email subscription service. Subscribers receive email notifications when new information becomes available, rather than using RSS feeds. You may unsubscribe at any time.

## **COURTROOMS OPEN FOR ALL HEARINGS**

Courtrooms are open to the public when hearings are scheduled. Parties may choose to appear in person, even if a remote option is available.

**U.S. BANKRUPTCY FILINGS RISE 11 PERCENT**

Total bankruptcy filings rose 11 percent, with increases in both business and non-business bankruptcies, in the twelve-month period ending December 31, 2025.

According to statistics released by the Administrative Office of the U.S. Courts, annual bankruptcy filings totaled 574,314 in the year ending December 2025, compared with 517,308 cases in the previous year.

Business filings rose 7.1 percent, from 23,107 to 24,737, in the year ending December 31, 2025. Non-business bankruptcy filings rose 11.2 percent to 549,577, compared with 494,201 in 2024.

For more than a decade, total filings fell steadily, from a high of nearly 1.6 million in September 2010 to a low of 380,634 in June 2022. Total filings have increased each quarter since then, but they remain far lower than historical highs.

**PARTY ROLE TYPE IN CM/ECF**

When filing a document in CM/ECF and adding a new party to the case (either a party you represent or yourself), you must select the correct **role** for that party on the Party Information screen, in addition to entering the required address information. The system defaults to Debtor. If you do not change this setting, the party will be added as a Debtor to the case. The drop-down menu includes multiple role options. Be sure to select the appropriate role type for your party before completing the entry.
