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NOTICE OF UPDATED PAYMENT POLICY

Beginning [August 1, 2026](#), the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of Nevada has updated the payment methods accepted by the Clerk's Office.

The Clerk's Office will no longer accept:

- ACH payments (via Pay.gov)
- Credit cards

The following payment methods will be accepted:

- Money order
- Cashier's check
- Debit card (via Pay.gov)
- PayPal (via Pay.gov)

This change applies only to payments made through the Clerk's Office. Registered CM/ECF e-filers are not affected and may continue using their existing electronic payment options.

TEMPORARY PACER FEE UPDATE

To fund the accelerated development of a modernized and highly secure national case management and public access system, the Judiciary is implementing a [temporary per-page fee increase](#) starting January 1, 2027, for electronic public access. This has been approved by the Executive Committee on behalf of the Judicial Conference.

Key Changes:

Per-Page Fee: The per-page fee increases by two cents, moving from 10 cents to 12 cents.

Quarterly Exemption: The automatic quarterly fee waiver will increase from \$30 to \$40.

Duration: The increase will remain in place for a five-year period.

Because of the increased fee waiver, individual users who incur \$40 or less in services per quarter will continue to incur no fee or fee increase. This is the first PACER fee adjustment in nearly 15 years; the last adjustment occurred in 2012 when the fee was raised from 8 cents to 10 cents.



PACER INTRODUCES NEW PASSWORD REQUIREMENTS

Beginning August 17, 2026, PACER users who have not updated their password in the last 18 months will be randomly selected to update their password to comply with the updated password standards. The new password must:

- Be 14-45 characters in length.
- Contain at least one lowercase letter, one uppercase letter, and one special character (all special characters are allowed).
- Not contain any part of your first name, last name, username, or email address.

Passwords must also be updated every 180 days. This will help reduce the risk of extended use of compromised passwords.

Impacted users will be prompted to update their password upon login. Users may skip the process three times before their account is locked. Once an account is locked, users will not be able to perform any activity until they change their password. Users are encouraged to update their password as soon as possible.

Users should ensure that they know their security questions and answers and have access to the email address associated with their PACER account in the event they need to reset their password. If users do not know their security questions and answers, they should contact the PACER Service Center for assistance. Users sharing their account should coordinate with their teams to avoid locking each other out. Finally, if using third-party software, users should check if they need to take any additional action as it relates to that software.
