BACKGROUND:

The U.S. Bankruptcy Court – District of Nevada has recently upgraded courtroom A/V technology to fully digital system. One item we did not replace was the projector, which we later found that it could not efficiently support the high definition video signal that the new system is outputting. Due to this reason, we now plan to purchase five (5) high definition laser projectors for our 5 large courtrooms and two (2) high definition laser projectors for our 2 smaller courtrooms.

SCOPE OF WORK:

1. Providing pricing proposal for five (5) high definition laser projectors (for our large courtrooms) that meet the following requirements:
 - Equipment quoted must be new product, no refurbished
 - Support native resolution of 1920 x 1200 (WUXGA) or higher
 - Minimum of 7,500 ANSI lumens
 - Maximum dimensions (L x W x H): 28" x 20" x 10"
 - Support digital HDMI input (also support analog input is a plus)
 - Built-in RJ45 LAN port and RS-232C control port.
 - Support power requirement of 100 – 240V
 - Total weight cannot exceed 62 lbs.
 - Include lens that will support throw distance of 38' (ft.) and project image that is 12' x 7.5' (ft.)
 - Include 3 years of parts and labor limited warranty on projector.
2. Providing pricing proposal for two (2) high definition laser projectors (for our smaller courtrooms) that meet the following requirements:
 - Equipment quoted must be new product, no refurbished
 - Support native resolution of 1920 x 1200 (WUXGA) or higher
 - Minimum of 6,000 ANSI lumens
 - Maximum dimensions (L x W x H): 30" x 20" x 7"
 - Support digital HDMI input (also support analog input is a plus)
 - Built-in RJ45 LAN port and RS-232C control port.
 - Support power requirement of 100 – 240V
 - Total weight cannot exceed 62 lbs.
 - Include lens that will support throw distance of 28' (ft.) and project image that is 12' x 7.5' (ft.)
 - Include 3 years of parts and labor limited warranty on projector.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

Pricing proposal should contain all costs associated with the new projector, including lens, extended warranty, and shipping charges. If the manufacturer warranty is less than 3 years for parts and labor, bidder needs to include the cost of extended warranty in the proposal so that the overall parts and labors warranty for the projector will be 3 years from the date of purchase.
