## **ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2014-03**

The Court has implemented the Electronic Proof of Claim (EPOC) system for the filing of proof of claims and the Electronic Financial Management Certificate (eFinCert) program for the filing of a certificate concerning a debtor's completion of the financial management course by an approved debtor education provider.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED filing a claim electronically through EPOC or filing of a certificate concerning a debtor's completion of the financial management course through eFinCert shall constitute the signature of the filer and shall have the same force and effect as if the filer signed a paper copy of the document.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED a claim filed through EPOC or a certificate concerning a debtor's completion of the financial management course filed through eFinCert shall state the name and title, if any, of the filer and shall contain an "/s/" with the name of the filer typed in the location where the signature would otherwise appear.
