

Pursuant to LR 1001(c), the bankruptcy judges of the District of Nevada hereby adopt this Administrative Order:

**Chapter 13 Dismissals or Conversions under Bankruptcy Rule 1017.**

- (a) If a debtor seeks to voluntarily convert a chapter 13 case pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 1307(a):** Debtor must file and serve the assigned chapter 13 trustee with a notice of conversion.
- (b) If a debtor seeks to voluntarily dismiss a chapter 13 case under 11 U.S.C. § 1307(b):** Debtor must file and serve the assigned chapter 13 trustee with an ex parte motion to dismiss.
- (c) If the assigned chapter 13 trustee or another party in interest seeks conversion or dismissal of a chapter 13 case under 11 U.S.C. § 1307(c):** The chapter 13 trustee or other party in interest must file a motion to convert or dismiss, set the motion for a court hearing, and serve the notice of the motion and hearing upon all required parties in compliance with LR 9014.
