
ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2018-05

Pursuant to LR 1001(c), the bankruptcy judges of the District of Nevada hereby adopt this Administrative Order and amend LR 5005 to read as follows:

LR 5005. ELECTRONIC FILING, SERVICE, AND TRANSMITTAL OF PAPERS

(b) **Signature.** The user log-in and password that are required to submit documents to the court's electronic case filing system serve as the filing user's (as that term is defined in LR 2002(a)(3)) signature on all electronic documents filed with the court. The user log-in and password may not be used as an accommodation for any other party. No Filing User or other person may knowingly permit or cause to permit a Filing User's password to be used by anyone other than an authorized agent of the Filing User. They also serve as a signature for purposes of Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9011, the other Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, the local rules of this court, and any other purpose for which a signature is required in connection with proceedings before the court. Any violation of this subsection may result in sanctions, including the suspension of a Filing User's account to electronically file.
