Pursuant to LR 1001(c), the bankruptcy judges of the District of Nevada hereby adopt this Administrative Order and amend LR 9037 to read as follows:

## LR 9037. PRIVACY- REDACTIONS.

- (a) <u>Procedure to redact protected private information from transcripts</u>. To promote electronic access to transcripts while also protecting personal privacy, the court has adopted procedures regarding the electronic availability of transcripts in accordance with the Judicial Conference of the United States' privacy policy and with Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9037. These procedures are available on the court's website.
- (b) <u>Procedure to redact protected private information from documents other than</u> <u>transcripts.</u> If a document other than a transcript is filed that contains personal data identifiers pursuant to Fed. R. Bankr. 9037(a), a party seeking to redact that information from the publicly accessed electronic docket may file a Notice of Redaction, with the redacted document included as the attachment.
- (c) Any request to redact information other than the personal data identifiers described in Fed. R. Bankr. P. 9037(a) shall be submitted to the court by motion.
