ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2022-02

Administrative Order 2020-10 initially adopted a temporary revision to Interim Bankruptcy Rule 1020(a), as part of the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (the “CARES Act”) which was signed into law on March 27, 2020. On March 27, 2021, the COVID-19 Bankruptcy Relief Extension Act (“Extension Act”) of 2021 was signed into law and extended the CARES Act’s bankruptcy-related amendments for an additional year. The Extension Act’s expiration date of March 27, 2022 was not extended by Congress.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Administrative Order 2020-10 is hereby **RESCINDED**, effective March 28, 2022.
