**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 2023-01**

In response to the coronavirus disease 2019 (“COVID-19”) pandemic in the District of Nevada and nationally, the Court previously issued a series of Administrative Orders. Those orders were temporary in nature. They were issued in an effort to contain the spread of COVID-19 in Nevada through actions consistent with federal and state guidance, while still affording the public access to justice through the Court.


Administrative Order 2020-03 adopted temporary restrictions on visitors to the United States Bankruptcy Court, District of Nevada’s Courthouses.

The Court has revisited the COVID-19 Administrative Orders in order to ensure that Court operations are carried out in a way that is consistent with the goals of reopening the Court, while minimizing the potential for transmission of COVID-19.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that Administrative Order 2020-03 is hereby **RESCINDED**.
