9 In response to the coronavirus disease 2019 (“COVID-19”) pandemic in the District of
10 Nevada and nationally, the Court previously issued a series of Administrative Orders. Those
11 orders were temporary in nature. They were issued in an effort to contain the spread of
12 COVID-19 in Nevada through actions consistent with federal and state guidance, while still
13 affording the public access to justice through the Court.

14 Administrative Order 2020-14 adopted temporary restrictions on in person hearings and
15 trials, along with suspending the requirement of delivering courtesy copies to the Court
16 pursuant to the Local Rules that were in effect at the time.

17 The Court has revisited the COVID-19 Administrative Orders in order to ensure that
18 Court operations are carried out in a way that is consistent with the goals of reopening the
19 Court, while minimizing the potential for transmission of COVID-19.

20 **IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED** that Administrative Order 2020-14 is hereby
21 **RESCINDED.**

22 **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that courtesy copy requirements are to be followed
23 according to the Guidelines of each Judge, which are available on the court’s website at
